







Ture Self: David Rosetzky Selected Works, currently at the Centre for Contemporary Photography, Melbourne, features exhibition design by Simon Whibley Architecture. True Self: David Rosetzky Selected Works is the first major survey of this leading Australian artist. Drawing on fifteen years of practice, it features early portrait and longer duration videos, photographs, photo-collages and sculpture, and will travel throughout Australia from 2013 - 15

Innovative settings for viewing screen-based works were developed in collaboration with the artist and curators, combining elements that cleverly conceal technology with custom designed and fabricated furniture pieces.

Sourced from the spaces and environments within the work itself, our design provides a material and spatial response to "clear the world away from the work", as briefed by CCP director Naomi Cass.

The design supports the presentation of these carefully crafted works across multiple venues.

Key considerations were:

- durability of exhibition elements
- ease of transportation
- simple reinstallation

This formed a robust palette of linoleum, steel and plywood.
